Spring Festival Market 2012, Competition Terms and Conditions

The Spring Festival Market ("Market") competition as detailed at www.bl.uk ("Competition") is operated by the British Library Board of 96 Euston Road, London NW1 2DB, United Kingdom, ("We" "Us" and "Our"). "You" and "Your" shall mean you, the person entering the Competition.

1 General

1.1 If You enter the Competition You are deemed to have agreed to abide by all of the following Terms and Conditions together with any amendments thereto (both of which are non-negotiable) under which the Competition is run, and to be bound by them. We may disqualify You without prior notice if You are in breach of any of these Terms and Conditions or any revised Terms and Conditions that We may from time to time impose.

1.2 We reserve the right to cancel the Competition at any stage if We deem this necessary or circumstances arise that are outside Our control.

2. Entries

2.1 The Competition is open to designers/ makers trading within the UK who meet the Competition criteria excluding:

2.1.1 employees of the British Library; or

2.1.2 any person directly involved in the running of the Competition, or their direct family members.

Entry is free. Only one entry will be accepted per person.

2.2 Applicants must be aged 18 years or older.

2.3 To enter the Competition, You must:

2.4.1 complete the form at www.bl.uk and tick the box on the form to accept these Terms and Conditions, and email it to springmarket@bl.uk; and

2.4.2 own the intellectual property rights necessary to exhibit and sell the products at the Market. For the avoidance of doubt, You agree to indemnify and hold us harmless from any cost, loss, liability or expense (including reasonable legal fees) incurred by us as a result of any claim, demand, or litigation brought against Us by any party other than You to the extent that the same is based upon or in any way arises from any breach or alleged breach of this clause 2.4.2.

2.4 All entries must be received by midnight on **Sunday 29 January 2012**. Any entries received after this will not be considered. We cannot be held responsible for:

2.4.1 ineligible or fraudulent entries; or

2.4.2 any lost or late entries, due to the Internet, email or postal service or otherwise, even where proof of sending can be provided.

2.5 We will select twelve winning entrees. The judge's decision shall be final, and no correspondence shall be entered into.

2.6 The results of the Competition will be announced on Friday 3 February 2012 on the British Library website. Winners will also be contacted on this day personally by email or telephone. It will not be possible to notify those entrants that do not win. The winners will gain the prize as detailed

at www.bl.uk ("Prize").

2.7 The winner<s> accept<s> and agree<s> that:

2.7.1 the Prize must be taken as stated, and cannot be deferred, exchanged or redeemed for its value;

2.7.2 no alternate to the Prize will be available; and

2.7.3. the Prize does not cover the costs of travel expenses for the winners. The Prize for Your Stand includes the stand itself, fabric covering, hooks, and some basic staging.

3. Rights and permissions

3.1 If We are unable to contact any winner after making reasonable efforts to do so, or the Prize is unclaimed after ten days then the Prize will be deemed to have been forfeited, and We reserve the right to offer the Prize to another entrant.

3.2 In the event that You are a winner, You agree to the following in relation to the Competition:

3.2.1 participate in any publicity planned by Us, including, but not limited to, on social media and in the local and national press; and

3.2.2 allow the posting of Your details on Our website.

3.2.3 You are able to attend a 1.5 hour workshop on the Market on week on Mon 13 Feb 10am – 12 midday.

4. Personal Data

4.1 We will only use your <email><contact> details for the purposes of administering this Competition, and, other than as expressly provided for in these Terms and Conditions, will not publish them or provide them to anyone without Your permission.

4.2 You consent to Us holding and processing data relating to You for legal, administrative and management purposes.

4.3 Any personal data relating to You will be used solely in accordance with current UK data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to another party without Your prior consent. Please see Our [Privacy Statement](#) for further details.

4.4 Data relating to You will be retained by Us for a reasonable period after the closing date specified in clause 2.4 to assist in the administration of the Competition in a consistent manner and to deal with any queries on the Competition.

5. Applicable Law

5.1 These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law. You hereby submit to and agree that the sole jurisdiction and venue for any actions that may arise under or in relation to the subject matter hereof shall be the English Courts.
