Notes

You can see existing notes for an item without being logged in but if you want to add a note, you will need to log in; this facility is only available to registered readers and document supply customers.

When writing a note, you must agree to the Library's terms and conditions. One of the conditions is that your name will be displayed next to the note you write and can be seen by everyone viewing that record. Your note can be traced back to you; the Library moderates notes posted and will remove any which it deems to be inappropriate.

To add a note, click on the **Notes & Tags** tab for the item for which you want to write a note. Then click on the **Add a note** link, and compose your note.
