FOREWORD

This catalogue relates to the papers of Charles Loudon Bloxam, a nineteenth century chemist. The papers consist of the correspondence of Bloxam, members of his family and other scientists. There are also papers relating to the publications of his textbooks, papers and notebooks relating to King's College School, King's College, London, the Royal College of Chemistry, the Royal Military Academy, Woolwich and miscellaneous items. The papers were donated to the Library by Dr David L. Bloxam, great grandson of Charles, on 3 September 2004.

INTRODUCTION

This catalogue relates to the papers of Charles Loudon Bloxam, a nineteenth century chemist. The papers were originally housed at King's College Archives and were then donated to the Library by Dr David L. Bloxam, great grandson of Charles Loudon Bloxam, on 3 September 2004.

Charles Loudon Bloxam was born in Meriden, Warwickshire on 23 March 1831. Bloxam was educated at King's College School between 1842 and 1843; from 1845 he went to train in Chemistry under Dr August Wilhelm Hofmann at the Royal College of Chemistry, subsequently becoming his Sub-Assistant and Assistant. Bloxam resigned from the College in 1852. His intention was to set up a private practice becoming a tutor and chemical analyst but by 1854 he had obtained a position as a demonstrator at King's College, London. In 1856 he succeeded John Eddowes Bowman as Chair of Practical Chemistry and in 1870, following the death of William Allen Miller, he became Professor of Chemistry.

In 1855 he also became a lecturer in chemistry at the Royal Military Academy, eventually becoming Professor of Chemistry and Physics. Bloxam resigned from the post in 1882 due to the lack of discipline and published the pamphlet 'On the Present Condition of the Royal Military Academy, Woolwich', which was discussed in Parliament. Bloxam was also a lecturer at the Royal Artillery College between 1864 and 1887.

In 1854 Bloxam was elected Fellow of the Chemical Society, of which he was an active member and sat on its Council. In 1877 he also became a founding member of the Institute of Chemistry alongside his long term friend and colleague Sir Frederick Augustus Abel.

Bloxam published his research mainly in *Chemical News* and *Journal of the Chemical Society* but is probably best known for his textbooks. In 1854 he and Abel published the *Handbook in Chemistry, Theoretical, Practical and Technical*. It was revised in 1867 as *Chemistry, Inorganic and Organic with Experiments, with a comparison of Equivalent and Molecular Formulae* with Bloxam as sole editor. It made eleven editions, the last published in 1923 and edited by his son Arthur George Bloxam and Samuel Judd Lewis. In 1869 he published *Laboratory Teaching or Progressive Exercises in Practical Chemistry*. This was a teach yourself manual of chemical analysis. At the time of his death it was on its fifth edition, the sixth and last edition was published in 1893.

Later in life Bloxam suffered from emphysema and following an attack of bronchitis he died on 28 November 1887. Bloxam was one of eight children; two of his brothers Matthew and William went on to become surgeons. Thomas assisted him at King's College before becoming Dr. George Wilson's assistant at the Industrial Museum of Scotland in 1855. He married Frederica Louisa Abel, sister of Frederick Abel in 1856. They had eight children, one of whom, Arthur George Bloxam, also became a chemist.
