## 1. PARLIAMENTARY PUBLICATIONS

### 1.1 Official records

The unicameral Assembleia da República is elected for four year terms by universal adult suffrage under a system of proportional representation. Executive power is vested in the President who is directly elected for a five-year term (for a maximum of two consecutive terms). The President appoints a Prime Minister, and, upon the latter's nomination, other members of the Council of Ministers.

## **2. LEGISLATION AND COURT REPORTS**

Primary and secondary Portuguese legislation is promulgated in Series 1 of the official gazette, the **Diário da República**. To 2006 Series 1 was issued in two parts, series A containing primary legislation and the budget, while series B covered secondary legislation. Series 2 contains public service job advertisements, appointments made, and other government notices and announcements. Series 3, which ceased publication in 2006, covers public competitions and planning applications. Finally, the **Apêndice** deals with local government by-laws. The **Diário** has been held by the British Library under various titles from 1820. To 1935 all series were shelved together at OGP.120. From 1936, Series 1 which contains the laws continued to be shelved at OGP.120. Other series were shelved separately:

In the Portuguese legal system the judgements of the courts are not in principal formal sources of law nor are they binding precedents for future cases. However some decisions (*Acórdãos*) of certain courts are a binding source of law. This is the case with decisions of:

- Tribunal Constitucional (Constitutional Court)
- Supremo Tribunal de Justiça (Supreme Court of Justice)
- Supremo Tribunal Administrativo (Supreme Administrative Court)

Judicial decisions of all these courts are published in Series 1, of the **Diário da República** (formerly series 1, Part A).
