### Copyright Status of Unpublished Materials in the UK

Although this item is legally in copyright in the UK until 2040, the British Library has decided to make these images available online. This indicates that there are no copyright restrictions on reproduction, adaptation, republication or sharing of the content available from the site for you if you are **not situated** in the UK, as well as to the best of our knowledge in Ireland and Australia.

Copyright status of manuscript material: The 1988 Copyright, Designs and Patents Act (as amended) states that most unpublished literary and artistic works from known authors from the EEA remain in copyright in the UK until at least 31 December 2040. Therefore important and unique parts of the national collection remain in copyright in the UK, created more than over 140 years ago. The Library believes that putting online unpublished material created many centuries ago and in the public domain in most countries in the world, is unlikely to undermine the interests of most descendants of these works.

As an institution whose role it is to support access to knowledge, we have therefore taken the decision to release certain digitised images technically still in copyright in the UK on this website for use by school students, teachers and the wider public.
