


HOW TO ACCESS ALEXANDER STREET VIDEO RESOURCES ON A PERSONAL DEVICE

If you have a [Reader Pass](#) you can access material from Alexander Street Video resources on a personal device, both in the Library's Reading Rooms and remotely.


The first time you connect to a document on your own device, via a record on [Explore the British Library](#), you should click **Sign in through your library to access more features**:


