

# HOW TO ACCESS EAST VIEW RESOURCES ON A PERSONAL DEVICE

If you have a [Reader Pass](#) you can access most East View resources on a personal device, both in the Library's Reading Rooms and remotely.

The first time you connect to an East View resource on your own device you will need to specify your institution. Type **British Library** in the 'Institution name or email...' text box:
